### **Training**

Full Training	\$850

Includes 3 group lessons and 1 training ride OR 1 private lesson per week. Basic supplies such as Fly spray, shampoo, and conditioner. Scheduling and managing of recommended vets and farriers. Scheduling and administration of dewormers, vaccinations and injections as needed. Medical care as needed. All clients are required to participate in a minimum of 2 shows per year. Venmo payments please add an additional 2.5% charge. Credit card payments please add an additional 3%. Paid directly to KL Equestrian Services LLC.

Weekly group lessons will feature two days of flat, poles and cavaletti, and four days of mixed flat and jumping. No more than three days of jumping per week including trainer jumping rides.

### **Additional Lessons for Full Training Clients**

Private Lesson or Training Ride	\$35
Semi Private Lesson (2-3 riders)	\$25
Group Lesson (4+ riders)	\$15
Upgrade Group Lesson to Private or Training Ride	\$25

A security deposit equal to each horse's monthly training fee will be collected when a horse enters the training program. Payments after the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month will incur a \$5/day late fee and no lessons or show services will be provided.



### **Lesson Rates for Clients Not in Full Training**

Private Lesson (45 min)	\$85
Semi-Private (2-3 riders 45 min-1 hr)	\$80
Group Lesson (4+ riders 1 hr)	\$75
Trailer-In Fee Per Horse	\$20 (or 3 for \$50)

No training rides will be offered to clients not in training.

### **Optional Feed Program**

Pro Series	\$200

High quality USDA certified organic and non-GMO feed. Only contains ingredients that are grown and processed according to federal guidelines for ingredient and soil quality, pest and weed control and use of additives. Includes supplement PROeq which targets joint, gut, brain and body health concerns. Low sugar and low starch option. Paid with monthly training bill directly to KL Equestrian Services LLC.

### **Show Rates**

Day Fee In Training	\$75
Day Fee Not In Training	\$100

Other fees to expect will be: Set Up Fee, Shipping, Trainer Expense (Hotel, travel, etc. divided evenly), Supplies, Medications, Splits (Groom/dressing/feed stalls, bedding), Night Watch, Clipping and mane pulling (Paid directly to service provider), Groom, Braider, and Show Office Fees.

Minimum of 4 horses required to go to show or different rates will be applied.

Nonrefundable down payment of \$250 is required one month in advance of all shows to attend. All bills paid on behalf of clients will incur an additional 20% fee.

Loyalty Program: Every 4 shows (per show season) clients will receive a \$150 (equal to two free day fee charges) credit on your show bill.

### **Commissions**

All Sales, Purchases and Leases	15%

Half of clients travel fees will be credited back when horse is purchased.
